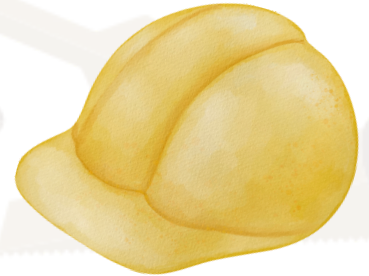

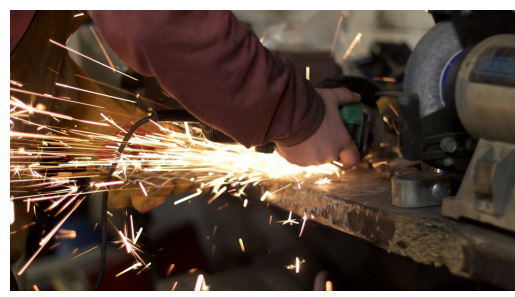
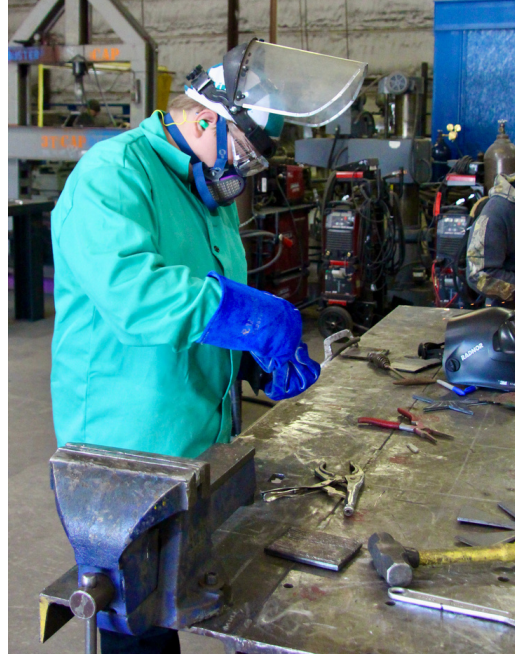


Camp is open to COP ESD students entering grades 10, 11, or 12 in Fall 2024
